Growing Greener 3 Grant – Let Your Voice be Heard!

There is a proposal in the Pennsylvania General Assembly called Growing Greener 3, which would invest \$500 million in conservation of open space and farmland, clean water initiatives, upgrades in state parks and forests, projects to reduce flooding, and trails, greenways, and parks. There is bipartisan support to use federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds for these local investments. The problem is that the representatives and senators who are championing this legislation have reported that they are not hearing about it from residents. All residents are encouraged to **call or email** your representative and senator as soon as possible, **tell them** that the issues listed above are important to you, and **ask them** to support Growing Greener 3, **ask them** to talk to their leadership in the PA House and Senate to urge their support of Growing Greener 3.
