Latest Updates

Independence Park: The Township was recently awarded a \$300,000 grant from DCNR and a \$250,000 grant from Chester County for the development of Phases 1 and 2 of Independence Park to include signage, link to the Schuylkill River trail, pavilion, and parking. The 96-acre property was once part of the Pennhurst State School and Hospital. The Master Plan for all phases and more information can be found on the Township website [here](#).

Township Code Revisions: Beginning this year, the Township started the process to review the Township Code which will be partially funded and assisted by Chester County through the Vision Partnership Program (VPP). The Code revision process involves assessing each chapter to make sure it is free of errors, consistent with local trends for land use, and is compliant with any recent changes to County, state, or federal law. A committee consisting of representatives from the Board of Supervisors and Planning Commission, Township staff and professionals, and a community representative are tasked with preparing draft text for discussion at public meetings. The committee work will be available on the Township website as it is generated.

Barton's Meadows WWTP Assessment: Since taking over all operations and administration of the Municipal Authority in 2011, the Township has been increasingly aware of difficulties in managing costs related to operation and maintenance of the Barton's Meadows wastewater treatment plant (WWTP). The Board of Supervisors has identified that a long-term plan to provide better financial stability and understanding for the longevity and useful life of the WWTP are needed. The Township recently awarded a contract to Environmental Engineering and Management Associates (EEMA) for \$13,000 to conduct an analysis of the plant and its operations. More information will be forthcoming over the next several months.
