The Environmental Advisory Council is always coming across educational & helpful articles to share with our residents. Please enjoy a snippet of this article from Homegrown National Park - Doug Tallamy. "Doug suggests that we prioritize our plant focus on enhancing populations to the insects that arguably have the greatest impact on terrestrial ecosystems, those that contribute the most energy to local food webs. These insects that: - are larger, more numerous, more edible, and more nutritious than most other insects - those responsible for most of the pollination required by plants. Priority Insects: - caterpillars, the larval stages of moths, butterflies - group of hymenopterans we call "sawflies" - 4,000 species of bees native to North America.
